"Current Developments in Yugoslavia's  
Domestic and Foreign Policies"

From one point on the political circle in our first meeting we move to quite another in our second this season. As a member of the League of Communists of Yugoslavia Ambassador Dimce Belovski helps make the top policy decisions of his country. He is also active in journalism both domestic and international. The Ambassador will be prepared to respond to questions on any aspect of Yugoslav affairs, including policies relating to the Cyprus and Middle East crises of recent months, crises in which Yugoslavia has sought to play a useful behind-the-scenes role.

Ambassador Belovski was educated as an attorney and took an active part in the National Liberation War of 1941-45. He held important political and military positions during and following the war. These included position in both the government and the party in Macedonia. In addition he was Director (Publisher) and Editor-in-Chief of New Macedonia, a daily. Later he served as Deputy Chief Delegate to the United Nations in New York, Ambassador to China (1961-65), and Assistant Secretary of State (1965-69).
