## STUDENTS DEDICATION PLEDGE

Conscious of the high dignity and nobility of my profession, fully aware of the sacred responsibility that I am assuming in entering upon the duties of my sublime calling, with a strong spirit of faith in the existence of God, my Creator, and in Christ, my Redeemer, as well as in the Holy Ghost, my Sanctifier, I solemnly pledge myself to the careful and continued observance of the highest and noblest ideas of my profession.
