

Simulator Checklist for MD 127

Arterial Puncture Wrist

Note: Make sure all the following items listed below are in the carrying case/container before re-shelving the simulator

- 1 Rubber Hand-Wrist model
- Set of 2 Skin Puncture units—each set has an outer and inner skin pad (four in all)
- 1 small plastic radial base to place skin pads on (yellowish color)
- Set of 4 Artery Tubes (with black and white connectors on each end)
- 1 Simulator Base (yellow) with connected tubes
- 1 Circulation Pump (brown)
- Set of 2 long Connector tubes for Base and Pump (have silver ends--one with red rings, other with black rings)
- 1 black Plug-in cord for Circulation Pump
- 2 plastic jars with white lids
- 1 bottle of blood powder

- 1 thin white spoon
- 1 thin white foam protective sheet
- 1 thick Foam packaging protective cover
- 2 White Pillows
- 1 thick blue pad to store Circulation Pump, Simulator Base, jars, and blood powder in

- 1 fourteen-page Instruction Manual
- 1 laminated “Important: Please Read Carefully Before Use” sheet
- 1 “Medical Definitions for MD 127” list
- 1 “Avoid Damage to Simulator” insert
